Incorporated in 2000, this philanthropic arm of our business awards direct grants to nonprofit organizations and provides additional financial support through our Employee/Office Match Program.

Take Advantage of Allegis Group's Employee Match Program

Here's where you come in! As a full-time employee, you can extend the dollars you raise by participating in a walkathon or other type of event to impact the organizations that matter to you the most.

- Individual employees are eligible for dollar-for-dollar matches up to \$1,000 per year.
- Teams are eligible for matching funds of up to \$3,000 per year when two or more employees in a local office or department support the same organization.

How Does it Work?

Employees love matching programs, and so do we! For more than 18 years, the Allegis Group Foundation has served as one of the backbones of our commitment to Corporate Social Responsibility. Here's how easy it is to receive support for your fundraising and volunteer efforts:

- All requests must be submitted through the Foundation Grant Application Form.
- Applicants must be full-time, internal employees based in the United States or Canada.
- Documentation of an organization's charitable status is required upon submission. U.S.-based organizations must be registered as 501(c)3 under the IRS tax code. Canadian-based organizations must qualify under the 149(1) Income Tax Act.
- Documentation of fundraising efforts is required, plan to attached an excel spreadsheet of colleague's names or a screenshot of your fundraising page. Requests will not be approved without proof of fundraising efforts.

Exclusions

- Contributions may not be made to individuals; fraternal organizations; churches or other religious organizations if intended to support faith-based initiatives; local youth athletics; or any organization that isn't exempt under the 501(c)(3) or 149(1) codes.
- The Allegis Group Foundation does not match personal donations. Employees must be actively volunteering with, or fundraising for, a nonprofit to be eligible for the match.
- Neither sponsorships nor entrance to charitable golf tournaments are eligible. Such requests will be filtered through each company's Accounts Payable Department.
 - If teams raise money for an organization by hosting a golf tournament, those funds will be considered on a case by case basis for a foundation match.
