Who Can Participate?

Individuals associated with Eaton who are:

• Eaton Employees • Retired Employees • Present or former directors Spouses are not eligible to participate.

How Much Can Be Contributed?

The minimum gift is \$25.

The maximum total gift, per individual, that will be matched in a calendar year is \$5.000.

What Can Be Contributed?

Personal cash/check/credit card contributions paid, not merely pledged, are eligible for the match, as well as securities having a quoted market value. The value of securities shall be determined on basis of the closing price on the day on which the gift was made. Donations must be charitable contributions by the individual for federal income tax purposes.

What Are The Program Limitations?

Only the tax-deductible portion of gifts will be matched. The organization must apply the matching funds to the same program as the donor's gift. The donor may receive no goods or services of value in exchange for a contribution to an organization.

What Gifts Will Not Be Matched?

Gifts to churches or religious organizations are not eligible for matching gifts. Gifts that are collections for walk-a-thons, fundraising activities, etc. are also not eligible.
